“Working through the g3 platform, PeopleNet will provide information on truck availability and we can then post that unit to help find the best routing and backhaul information,” says Gayle Robertson, principal of the Robertson Group and the developer of BOLT. “At the touch of a button, you can get fleet (or unit) revenue/cost/profit per mile, monthly maintenance costs for each truck or the entire fleet, current status of quarterly fuel tax and more.”

The system manages all back-office functions providing fleets with optimized routing, shipment and asset tracking, and enroute refueling locations. BOLT tracks maintenance and fuel taxes, tire performance, preventive maintenance and inspection schedules, and CDL and medical cards expiration dates.
